The Chosen S1, Ep1: I Have Called You by Name

SUMMARY: *Two brothers struggle with a Jewish tax collector over their debts to Rome; a Pharisee confronts a demon-possessed woman in the "Red Quarter" of Capernaum. (53:00)*

3. In what new ways (if any) do you view God's love and the mystery of redemption now, after seeing this first episode?
