The Chosen S1, Ep 3: Jesus Loves the Little Children

SUMMARY: *Jesus befriends and teaches the group of children who discover His camp on the outskirts of Capernaum. (33:00)*

You are invited to watch this episode as if you are a curious child.

- 1. When Jesus listens to the children pray the Shema, he appears to be emotional. Why do you think this is?**
- 2. The encounter between Jesus and the children is situated in 26 AD (about 2-4 years before Jesus begins his public ministry). What key points do we learn about Jesus through his teaching and interaction with the children?**
- 3. What is the text Jesus recites when asked by the children, “What is your reason for being here?”. When in our Gospels do we hear Jesus recite this passage again? Thinking back to your insights in the episodes we have seen up to now, why is this scriptural text significant as the heart of Jesus’ message and His “reason for being here”?**
