SUMMARY: *With his life and family under threat from Rome, Simon spends one last night fishing in a desperate attempt to square his debts. Andrew spots a familiar face waiting for them on the shores of Galilee. (45:00)*

3. What have the episodes you have seen thus far taught you about Mary, Simon, Nicodemus and Matthew? How have the circumstances of their lives opened themselves up to the wonder and possibilities that Jesus is the Messiah?
