In the last few episodes of Season 1, Simon is surprised when Jesus calls Matthew and still hasn't warmed to him.</p> <p>What shadows can a shared history or preconceived notions have when you and a former enemy are fighting for the same cause (particularly a cause of faith)? What steps can be taken to surmount those obstacles?</p>	<p>2. The Samaritan woman is elated as she repeats his words, that God will want worshippers in "spirit and truth."</p> <p>What does it mean to you to worship in spirit and truth? How can you get closer to that?</p>	<p>3. Season 1's finale ends with Jesus and the Chosen following the woman at the well into the Samaritan city. Simon gets very excited. Previously, he indicated that he was waiting for Jesus to fight back against the Romans.</p> <p>Is this what the Chosen think is currently happening? How might they react if that does not happen?</p>	<p>4. The Chosen, as they walk over the hill towards the city and the beginning of Jesus' public ministry, present a very disparate group (<i>above</i>).</p> <p>What advantages does this have? How could that be seen in the church of today?</p>	<p>5. How far do you think Season 2 will go in the Gospel stories?</p> <p>Is there any one Gospel story that you would want to see played out in this dramatic fashion? What features do you think would be highlighted to bring it to life?</p>
